 - GFOA's president is expected to represent the organization and serve as a brand ambassador for the organization. Please identify what "brand" message you would communicate.
 - 3) Please identify one of GFOA's greatest strengths. How would you build on that strength? Any areas of concern?
 - 4) GFOA uses its standing committees and affinity groups to develop future leaders for the association. How would you as president help improve the experience of volunteer leaders in the association so GFOA can continue to recruit top professionals for leadership positions?
 - 5) Describe the ideal working relationship between the GFOA board president and CEO?
