About this Webinar

- COVID-19 required employees to work from home, but it also forced organizations to rethink their business processes that require access to the office or involve large amounts of paper.
- This webinar will provide Do It Yourself (DIY) and COTS opportunities for governments to move away from paper-based processes.

Methods for Opportunities

- DIY
 - Easy, basic solutions to reduce paper using low or no cost, commonly available technologies.
 - Photographs
 - Spreadsheets
- COTS (commercial off the shelf)
 - Microsoft SharePoint
 - WuFoo

Opportunity #1 Electronic Routing and Workflow Instead of Paper Forms

- Paper is still used for routing and workflow approvals
 - Multi-page PO approval, etc.
- DIY Opportunity
 - Send an email or text to the appropriate person and he/she can reply
- COTS Opportunity
 - Look for existing technology within your organization. You may already have solutions to meet your needs
 - Document Management Systems
 - ERP systems (if modern)
 - Microsoft SharePoint
 - Microsoft Power Automate (part of Office 365)



Opportunity #2 Electronic Time Sheets

 Many governments still have employees submit paper time sheets (payroll, labor allocation for projects and programs)

DIY Opportunity

- Employees can fill out their timesheet at home, then take a picture of it and text or email it to their manager for approval
- Employees or managers can create a spreadsheet, then employees enter their time, then email the spreadsheet to their approver. Or employees can post to a shared drive
 - Lisa will provide example
- COTS Opportunity
 - Free or low-cost time sheet and project management software can be used to track employee's time

Opportunity #3 Electronic Forms Tools

- Governments still rely on paper applications or forms that are hand delivered to the office. Electronic form-building tools allow users to create forms to collect data, files, and payments
- DIY Opportunity
 - Allow citizens to download the application/form from your website to fill out where they scan or take a picture of the completed application/form, and then email it to the appropriate department
- COTS Opportunity
 - Eliminate the paper form altogether by creating an online form that will capture the same information as the paper version.

 - Zoho Forms
 - Google Forms



Opportunity #4 eSignatures

• Many governments require wet signatures, where a person physically signs a document (e.g., contracts, time sheets, invoices). Governments should consider the use of electronic signatures (eSignatures).

- COTS Opportunity
 - DocuSign
 - Sign Now
 - PandaDoc

Opportunity #5 Issue Paychecks via Direct Deposit

- Printing checks requires staff to work from the office. Many organizations use direct deposit to pay employees as a way to avoid printing, stuffing envelopes, and mailing paychecks.
- DIY Opportunity
 - Set up an online form and have employees enter their banking information, or have them take a picture of a voided check and email or text it to payroll. Payroll can then update employee banking information to process direct deposit

Opportunity #6 Issue Electronic Payments to Vendors

- Many governments still issue and mail paper checks when those payments can be transmitted electronically
- DIY Opportunity
 - Set up an online form and have vendors provide their banking information in the form.
 - Vendors can also email or text a picture of their banking information.
 - Accounts payable can then update their record and process payments electronically

Opportunity #7 Accept Electronic Payments

- Accepting in-person checks or cash payments (property taxes, business license, etc.) is inefficient and unhealthy for the community (social distancing).
- DIY Opportunity
 - Create an Adobe-fillable form and have your customers fill out their banking and routing information.
 - Customers can also email or text a picture of a voided check.
 - · Organizations can then set up the account for autodraft for future payments.
- COTS Opportunity
 - Set up an interactive voice response (IVR) system, where customers can make payments over the phone or via a website. IVR systems will act as the thirdparty payment collection provider

Opportunity #8 Create Electronic Accounts Receivable/Billing

- Local governments that do not have an accounts receivable module in their financial system (or ERP) often issue paper invoices to customers.
- DIY Opportunity
 - Create a Word (or electronic) version of an invoice and email it to the customer instead of a paper invoice
- COTS Opportunity
 - Implementing an ERP or financial system that includes an accounts receivable module will allow an organization to issue invoices (or templates) electronically through the system

Security Considerations

- Speak to your IT department to ensure you are adhering to security policies
- Ensure virus checker is turned on
- Ensure Firewall has been implemented
- Ensure COTS systems are PCI compliant
- Ensure form builder is secure
 - https://www.wufoo.com/security/
- Use a secure payment gateway
- Use secure signatures and data encryption
- Ensure security policies are in place for your organization


